

The Holy Spirit: Who He Is

John 14:15–26

1. *He Is the Counsellor, Comforter and other Helper*

- a. His presence is conditional:
Must love Jesus
- b. His presence is given forever

2. *He is the Spirit of truth*

- a. The world cannot accept Him
- b. The believer receives Him and knows Him

3. *He is the personal presence of Christ*

- a. A spiritual presence, not a physical presence
- b. A living, eternal presence
- c. A living union between God, Christ and the believer

4. *He is the very special manifestation of Christ within the believer*

- a. The special presence is conditional:
Must obey and love Christ
- b. The special presence is questioned

15 “If you love me,
you will obey what I command.

16 And I will ask the Father,
and he will give you another Counsellor
to be with you forever —

17 The Spirit of truth.
The world cannot accept him,
because it neither sees him nor knows him.
But you know him,
for he lives with you and will be in you.

18 I will not leave you as orphans;
I will come to you.

19 Before long,
the world will not see me anymore,
but you will see me.
Because I live, you also will live.

20 On that day you will realize
that I am in my Father,
and you are in me, and I am in you.

21 Whoever has my commands
and obeys them,
he is the one who loves me.
He who loves me
will be loved by my Father,
and I too will love him
and show myself to him.”

22 Then Judas (not Judas Iscariot) said,
“But, Lord,
why do you intend
to show yourself to us
and not to the world?”

My Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our home with him.</p> <p>24 He who does not love me will not obey my teaching. These words you hear are not my own; they belong to the Father who sent me.</p> <p>25 “All this I have spoken while still with you.</p> <p>26 But the Counsellor, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.</p>

<p>1. <i>The source of peace</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. The peace of the world b. The peace of Christ c. The source: Jesus Christ 	<p>27 Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.</p>
<p>2. <i>The source of joy</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. The return of Jesus to the Father (His death, resurrection and ascension) b. The Father's greatness c. The believer's faith confirmed 	<p>28 "You heard me say, 'I am going away and I am coming back to you.' If you loved me, you would be glad that I am going to the Father, for the Father is greater than I.</p> <p>29 I have told you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe.</p>
<p>3. <i>The source of security</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. The victory of Jesus Christ over the prince of the world b. The obedience of Jesus Christ to the Father 	<p>30 I will not speak with you much longer, for the prince of this world is coming. He has no hold on me,</p> <p>31 But the world must learn that I love the Father and that I do exactly what my Father has commanded me. Come now; let us leave."</p>
