 - b. Jesus is the Son of God
- 3. The great result: Life

- 30 Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book.
- 31 But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
