The Work of the Holy Spirit John 16:07–15

1. He helps believers

- a. His help:To replace Christ's presence for the believer's good
- b. His name: The Counselor, the Comforter, the Helper
- 2. He convicts the world of sin, righteousness and judgment
 - a. Of sin: Because they did not believe in Jesus
 - b. Of righteousness: BecauseJesus' righteousness is provenHe is ascended as Lord
 - c. Of judgment:

 Because Jesus condemned
 Satan (Heb. 2:14-15)

3. He guides believers

- a. Through guiding them into all truth
- b. Through speaking the truth
- c. Through showing them things to come
- 4. He glorifies Jesus Christ:
 He shows the things of Christ
 to believers
 - a. This includes the things of the Father
 - b. This includes what Christ wants revealed

- 7 But I tell you the truth:
 It is for your good that I am going away.
 Unless I go away,
 the Counselor will not come to you;
 but if I go,
 I will send him to you.
- 8 When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment:
- 9 In regard to sin, because men do not believe in me;
- 10 In regard to righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer;
- 11 And in regard to judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.
- 12 "I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear.
- 13 But when he,
 the Spirit of truth, comes,
 he will guide you into all truth.
 He will not speak on his own;
 he will speak only what he hears,
 and he will tell you what is yet to come.
- 14 He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you.
- 15 All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will take from what is mine and make it known to you."
