# The Minister's Life Was Completely Changed Galatians 01: 10–16

### 1 He sought to please God not men

## 10 Am I now trying to win the approval of men, or of God? Or am I trying to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a servant of Christ.

### 2 He proclaimed the gospel

- a. Not a man-made gospel
- b. Not received from man
- c. A revelation from Christ

#### 3 He had a radical change of life

- a. His former experience
  - 1) An arch-persecutor
  - 2) A supreme example of self-righteousness
- b. His radical change
  - 1) Set apart and called by God's grace
  - 2) Called as a minister to reveal Christ
  - 3) Called to preach Christ
  - 4) Called to seek his gospel from God alone

- 11 I want you to know, brothers, that the gospel I preached is not something that man made up.
- 12 I did not receive it from any man, nor was I taught it; rather, I received it by revelation from Jesus Christ.
- 13 For you have heard of my previous way of life in Judaism, how intensely I persecuted the church of God and tried to destroy it.
- 14 I was advancing in Judaism beyond many Jews of my own age and was extremely zealous for the traditions of my fathers.
- 15 But when God, who set me apart from birth and called me by his grace, was pleased
- 16 To reveal his Son in me so that I might preach him among the Gentiles. I did not consult any man.

# The Minister Followed God First in His life Galatians 01: 17–24

- 1 First, he went to Arabia: He got alone with God
- 2 Second, he returned to Damascus: He corrected the wrong he had previously done
- 3 Third, he went to Jerusalem: He faced his past, vv. 13-14
  - a. Faced Peter and James:Faced them as an equaldid not consult themabout the gospel
  - b. A solemn protest, see vv. 11-12
- 4 Fourth,
  he went to Syria and Cilicia,
  that is, Tarsus:
  He faced his hometown
- 5 The result of a God-centred life
  - a. His testimony spread
  - b. His life honoured God

- 17 Nor did I go up to Jerusalem to see those who were apostles before I was, but I went immediately into Arabia and later returned to Damascus.
- 18 Then after three years,
  I went up to Jerusalem
  to get acquainted with Peter
  and stayed with him fifteen days.
- 19 I saw none of the other apostlesonly James,the Lord's brother.
- 20 I assure you before God that what I am writing you is no lie.
- 21 Later I went to Syria and Cilicia.
- 22 I was personally unknown to the churches of Judea that are in Christ.
- 23 They only heard the report:
  "The man who formerly persecuted us
  is now preaching the faith
  he once tried to destroy."
- 24 And they praised God because of me.
