1. *The coming of the Saviour:*
From the Branch of Jesse

2. *The qualification of the Saviour:*
God's Spirit rests on Him

- a. In wisdom and understanding
- b. In counsel and power
- c. In knowledge and the fear of God

3. *The future work of the Saviour*

- a. He will establish true righteousness and justice
 - 1) He will not judge by appearance or hearsay
 - 2) He will execute perfect righteousness and justice for the poor and the meek
 - 3) He will execute judgment against the wicked, slaying them with the breath of His mouth, Rev 19:15
 - 4) He will wear righteousness and faithfulness as a belt
- b. He will restore creation itself and bring peace to the earth
 - 1) The nature of animals will be radically changed: From wild and ferocious to tame and peaceful
 - 2) The nature of man — even that of a child — will be totally changed

1 A shoot will come up from the stump of Jesse; from his roots a Branch will bear fruit.

2 The Spirit of the Lord will rest on him — the Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the Spirit of counsel and of power, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord —

3 and he will delight in the fear of the Lord. He will not judge by what he sees with his eyes, or decide by what he hears with his ears;

4 but with righteousness he will judge the needy, with justice he will give decisions for the poor of the earth. He will strike the earth with the rod of his mouth; with the breath of his lips he will slay the wicked.

5 Righteousness will be his belt and faithfulness the sash around his waist.

6 The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together; and a little child will lead them.

7 The cow will feed with the bear, their young will lie down together, and the lion will eat straw like the ox.

8 The infant will play near the cobra's den, the young child will put his hand into the viper's den.

3) The destruction of life and property will cease: Because the knowledge of God (His love and peace) will fill the earth

c. He will save the Gentiles

1) He will be a banner to rally all people, 49:22

2) He will live in a glorious place of rest

d. He will save a remnant of Jewish believers, free His people for a second time, 16

1) He will bring His people back from all nations

2) He will raise a banner to rally His people from all over the earth

3) He will heal the division between Israel and Judah, Eze. 37:15-28; Hos 1:11

- They will no longer be jealous or hostile
- They will unite, defeat and be victorious over all their enemies

4) He will remove all obstacles that hinder the return of His people to the promised land

- He will carry out a second Exodus, Exo 14:21-22

9 They will neither harm nor destroy on all my holy mountain, for the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea.

10 In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious.

11 In that day that the Lord will reach out his hand a second time to reclaim the surviving remnant of his people from Assyria, from Lower Egypt, from Upper Egypt, from Cush, from Elam, from Babylonia, from Hamath and from the islands of the Mediterranean.

12 He will raise a banner for the nations and gather the exiles of Israel; he will assemble the scattered people of Judah from the four quarters of the earth.

13 Ephraim's jealousy will vanish, and Judah's enemies will be destroyed; Ephraim will not be jealous of Judah, nor Judah hostile towards Ephraim.

14 They will swoop down on the shops of Philistia to the west; together they will plunder the people to the east. They will subdue Edom and Moab, and the Ammonites will be subject to them.

15 The LORD will dry up the gulf of the Egyptian sea; with a scorching wind he will sweep his hand over the Euphrates River. He will break it up into seven streams so that anyone can cross over in sandals.

- He will make a great highway for His people

1 *The song of praise for the Saviour:*

True reasons to praise the Lord

a. God will turn away from wrath and comfort His people

1) Because God is their salvation, strength and song

2) Because God will provide water, that is, the basic necessities of life

b. God will flood His people with joy and the desire to proclaim His name

1) To share with the nations what He has done for them, 11:11-16

2) To exalt His name

3) To make known all His glorious works

c. God — the Holy One of Israel — will dwell among them

16 There will be a highway for the remnant of his people that is left from Assyria, as there was for Israel when they came up from Egypt.

CHAPTER 12

1 In that day you will say: “I will praise you LORD. Although you were angry with me, your anger has turned away and you have comforted me.

2 Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; he has become my salvation.

3 With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

4 In that day you will say: “Give praise to the LORD, proclaim his name; make known among the nations what he has done, and proclaim that his name is exalted.

5 Sing to the LORD, for he has done glorious things; let this be known to all the world.

6 Shout aloud and sing for joy, people of Zion, for great is the Holy One of Israel among you.
