#### 2 By loving as Christ loved

- a. He made an offering to God sacrificed Himself
- b. He became a sweet fragrance to God
- 3 By being clean-bodied, that is, morally pure
- 3 But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed,

because these are improper for God's holy people.

- 4 By being clean-mouthed
- 4 Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving.

#### 5 By knowing God's solemn warning

- a. Uncleanness has no part with God
- b. There are deceivers
- c. The wrath of God is coming
- 6 By separating himself from the unclean

- 5 For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person
  - such a man is an idolater has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.
- 6 Let no one deceive you with empty words,
   for because of such things
   God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient.
- 7 Therefore do not be partners with them.

## The Believer is to Walk as a Child of Light Ephesians 05: 08–14

- 1 Light, not darkness, is the nature of believers
- 2 Light bears the things of life - the fruit of the Spirit
- 3 Light shows what is acceptable, pleasing
- 4 Light exposes the deeds of darkness
  - a. The charge:Have no fellowship with darkness
  - b. The reason:It is a shame to even speak of the things done in secret
- 5 Light reveals and converts everything it touches
- 6 Light awakens the sleeping
  - a. The challenge:Arise from the dead
  - b. How: By Christ

- 8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light
- 9 (For the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth)
- 10 And find out what pleases the Lord.
- 11 Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them.
- 12 For it is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret.
- 13 But everything exposed by the light becomes visible,
- 14 For it is light that makes everything visible.

  This is why it is said:

  "Wake up, O sleeper,

  rise from the dead,

  and Christ will shine on you."

1	By looking around and watching every step	15 Be very careful, then, how you live - not as unwise but as wise,
2	By redeeming the time, making the most of every opportunity	16 Making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.
3	By understanding the Lord's will	17 Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.
4	By rejecting drunkenness	18 Do not get drunk on wine,
5	By being filled with the Spirit	which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.
	a. A singing spirit	19 Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs.  Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord.
