- 1. His birth was of the Holy Spirit
- 2. His birth created a predicament
 - a. Mary's predicament:She was pregnantbefore marriage
 - b. Joseph's predicament: How to deal with Mary
 - 1) His character: A righteous man
 - 2) His solution: Not to expose Mary
- 3. His birth necessitated a special revelation from God
 - a. God gave assurance
 - 1) Joseph was chosen
 - 2) Joseph was not to fear
 - b. God guided:
 Joseph was to take Mary
 as His wife
 - c. God explained:
 The child is of the Spirit
 - d. God revealed the child's destiny
 - 1) His name: Jesus
 - 2) His mission: To save

18 This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about:
His mother Mary was pledged

His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit.

- 19 Because Joseph her husband was a righteous man and did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.
- 20 But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.
- 21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."

- 4. His birth was a fulfillment of prophecy, Isa 07:14
 - a. Predicting His virgin birth
 - b. Predicting His name:Emmanuel,God with us
- 5. His birth stirred a great obedience within Joseph He wed Mary

- 22 All this took place to fulfil what the Lord had said through the prophet:
- 23 "The virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel"

 which means,

 "God with us."
- 24 When Joseph woke up, he did what the angel of the Lord had commanded him and took Mary home as his wife.
