Hebrewsw 07: 25–28

1 *The High Priest with a perfect power*

- a. Lives forever
- b. Intercedes for man
- c. Saves completely
- d. Saves all who come

2 *The High Priest with a perfect life*

- a. Holy and blameless
- b. Unstained and different from sinners
- c. Exalted to the highest, v. 26

3 *The High Priest with a perfect sacrifice*

- a. The need: Not for His own sins...
- b. The sacrifice: Himself
- c. The finality: Once for all

4 *The High Priest with a perfect appointment*

- a. Is by God's oath, not by law
- b. Is perfect - free from weakness
- c. Is perfect forever - eternal

25 Therefore

he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.

26 Such a high priest meets our need

- one who is holy, blameless, pure, set apart from sinners, exalted above the heavens.

27 Unlike the other high priests,

he does not need to offer sacrifices day after day, first for his own sins, and then for the sins of the people. He sacrificed for their sins once for all when he offered himself

28 For the law appoints as high priests

men who are weak; but the oath, which came after the law, appointed the Son, who has been made perfect forever.
