We do have such a high priest,
who sat down at the right hand
of the throne of the Majesty in heaven,</p> <p>2 And who serves in the sanctuary,
the true tabernacle
set up by the Lord, not by man.</p> <p>3 Every high priest is appointed
to offer both gifts and sacrifices,
and so it was necessary for this one also
to have something to offer.</p> <p>4 If he were on earth,
he would not be a priest,
for there are already men
who offer the gifts prescribed by the law.</p> <p>5 They serve at a sanctuary
that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven.
This is why Moses was warned
when he was about to build the tabernacle:
“See to it that you make everything
according to the pattern shown you
