John 03: 18-21

- 1. Who is condemned:

 Not the believer but the unbeliever
- 2. When is he condemned: Already
- 3. Why is he condemned
 - a. He has not believed in Christ, the Son of God
 - b. Light has come into the world
 - c. He loves darkness; loves his evil, his sin
 - d. He does not come to the light
- 4. Who escapes condemnation
 - a. He who practices truth
 - b. He who comes to the light
 - c. He whose works are done through God

- 18 Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son.
- 19 This is the verdict:

 Light has come into the world,
 but men loved darkness instead of light
 because their deeds were evil.
- 20 Everyone who does evil hates the light, and will not come into the light for fear that his deeds will be exposed.
- 21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what he has done has been done through God."
