- a. To make disciples of all nations
- b. To baptize
- c. To teach all that He had commanded
- 4. He promised to be with His disciples

- 16 Then the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go.
- 17 When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted.
- 18 Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
- 19 Therefore
  go and make disciples of all nations,
  baptizing them
  in the name of the Father

  and of the Holy Spirit,
