## The Whole Creation Will Be Freed from Struggling and Suffering Romans 08: 18–27

- 1. The believer suffers and struggles in this life
- a. The fact stated
- b. The future glory will be worth the agony
- 2. The creation suffers and struggles for deliverance from corruption
- a. Creation is subject to corruption
- b. Creation will be delivered
- c. Creation groans in labour for deliverance
- 3. The believer suffers and struggles for deliverance from corruption
- a. The Holy Spirit who is the first fruits or foretaste of future glory, delivers and saves him
- b. Hope delivers and saves him

- c. Prayer and the Spirit deliver and save him
- d. God delivers and saves him through the Spirit's intercession and prayer

- 18 I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.
- 19 The creation waits in eager expectation for the sons of God to be revealed.
- 20 For the creation was subjected to frustration, not by its own choice, but by the will of the one who subjected it, in hope
- 21 That the creation itself will be liberated from its bondage to decay and brought into the glorious freedom of the children of God.
- 22 We know that the whole creation has been groaning as in the pains of child-birth right up to the present time.
- 23 Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.
- 24 For in this hope we were saved. But hope that is seen is no hope at all. Who hopes for what he already has?
- 25 But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it patiently.
- 26 In the same way,the Spirit helps us in our weakness.We do not know what we ought to pray for,but the Spirit himself intercedes for uswith groans that words cannot express.
- 27 And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints in accordance with God's will.
