- 5 Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."
- 6 So we say with confidence,"The Lord is my helper;I will not be afraid.What can man do to me?"
- 7 Remember your leaders,who spoke the word of God to you.Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith.
