- 1. The basic law
  - a. Owe no man anything
  - b. Owe no man anything but love
- 2. Love forbids adultery
- 3. Love forbids murder
- 4. Love forbids stealing
- 5. Love forbids covetousness
- 6. Love sums up all the commandments
- 7. Love does no harm to a neighbour

- 8 Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for he who loves his fellow-man has fulfiled the law.
- 9 The commandments,
  - "Do not commit adultery"
  - "Do not murder,"
  - "Do not steal,"
  - "Do not covet,"

and whatever other commandment there may be, are summed up in this one rule:

- "Love your neighbour as yourself."
- 10 Love does no harm to its neighbour.

  Therefore love is the fulfilment of the law.
