

The Sending Out of the Disciples

Mark 06: 07-13

(Mt. 9:35-10:42; Lk. 9:1-6)

1. *The disciples were equipped*

- a. Were called to Him
- b. Were sent two by two
- c. Were given authority

2. *The disciples were instructed*

- a. Were to live in utter simplicity and humility
- b. Were to show stability and settledness
- c. Were to reject any who were not hospitable and receptive
 - 1) The reason: As a warning
 - 2) The judgment: Terrible
- d. Were to preach repentance
- e. Were to minister to the demon-possessed and the sick

7 Calling the Twelve to him, he sent them out two by two and gave them authority over evil spirits.

8 These were his instructions:
“Take nothing for the journey except a staff – no bread, no bag, no money in your belts.

9 Wear sandals but not an extra tunic.

10 Whenever you enter a house, stay there until you leave that town.

11 And if any place will not welcome you or listen to you, shake the dust off your feet when you leave, as a testimony against them.”

12 They went out and preached that people should repent.

13 They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.
