The Charges Against the People, Israel Acts 07:42–53

- People did not worship God, but false gods
 - 1) Worshipped the "heavenly bodies"
 - 2) Results:
 God turned and gave them up
- People did not carry the tabernacle of God, but of false gods
 - 1) Molech and Rephan
 - 2) Result:
 The people were conquered
- 3. The people were inexcusable:

 Because they were greatly blessed
 - 1) They had the tabernacle of God's presence
 - 2) They had the presence and favour of God in great leaders

- 3) They had the temple
- 4. The people did not understand the temple —God is not limited only to one particular place

- 42 "But God turned away and gave them over to the worship of the heavenly bodies. This agrees with what is written in the book of the prophets:
 'Did you bring me sacrifices and offerings forty years in the desert,
 O house of Israel?
- 43 You have lifted up the shrine of Molech and the star of your god Rephan, the idols you made to worship.

 Therefore I will send you into exile' beyond Babylon.
- 44 Our forefathers had the tabernacle of the Testimony with them in the desert.It had been made as God directed Moses, according to the pattern he had seen.
- 45 Having received the tabernacle, our fathers under Joshua brought it with them when they took the land from the nations God drove out before them.

 It remained in the land until the time of David,
- 46 Who enjoyed God's favour and asked that he might provide a dwelling place for the God of Jacob.
- 47 But it was Solomon who built the house for him.
- 48 However, the Most High does not live in houses made by men. As the prophet says:
- 49 'Heaven is my throne,and the earth is my footstool.What kind of house will you build for me?says the Lord.Or where will my resting place be?

50 Has not my hand made all these things?' 5. The people resisted the Holy Spirit 51 You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always resist the Holy Spirit! 52 Was there ever a prophet 6 The people persecuted all the prophets, the very ones who predicted your fathers did not persecute? the coming of the Righteous One They even killed those who predicted (Christ) the coming of the Righteous One. And now you have betrayed 7. The people fulfilled the prophecy: and murdered him — Killed the Righteous One 53 You who have received the law 8. The people did not keep the law that was put into effect through angels but have not obeyed it."
