Jesus' challenge to Pilate: 34 "Is that your own idea," Jesus asked, A person is responsible "or did others talk to you about me?" for his own verdict c. Pilate's reaction: 35 "Am I a Jew?" Pilate replied. Contempt for the Jews "It was your people and your chief priests who handed you over to me. What is it you have done?" d. Jesus' explanation: 36 Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world. His kingdom is not If it were, my servants would fight of this world to prevent my arrest by the Jews. But now my kingdom is from another place." e. Pilate's baffled question: 37 "You are a king, then!" said Pilate. Is Jesus a king? Jesus answered, "You are right in saying I am a king. f. Jesus' claim: In fact. He is King – to be King for this reason I was born, was the purpose for His birth and for this I came into the world, to testify to the truth. g. Jesus' subtle appeal: Everyone on the side of truth listens to me." To hear His words h. Pilate's sincere question: 38 "What is truth?" Pilate asked. What is truth? With this he went out again to the Jews and said, "I find no basis for a charge against him."
