- a. To God and Christ
- b. To visit the church

2 The great need: Love

- a. To love "everyone"
- b. The source of love:
 The Lord
 and His "agape" love

3 The great result of love

- a. To be presented blameless before God
- b. When:At the return of the Lord Jesus Christ

- 11 Now may our God and Father himself and our Lord Jesus clear the way for us to come to you.
- 12 May the Lord make your love increase and overflow for each other and for everyone else, just as ours does for you.
- 13 May he strengthen your hearts so that you will be blameless and holy in the presence of our God and Father when our Lord Jesus comes with all his holy ones.

Walk That Pleases God (Part I): A Life of Purity 1 Thessalonians 04:01–08

1 The earnest but tender exhortation

- a. Live to please God, and do so more and more
- b. Keep the commandments given you by the Lord Jesus
- 2 The commandment: God's will is your sanctification
 - a. Avoiding sexual immorality
 - b. Knowing how to control your body and spouse
 - c. Resisting lustful passion
- 3 The reasons for purity
 - a. Immorality cheats and wrongs a brother
 - b. Immorality shall be revenged by God
 - c. Immorality is not God's call; holiness is
 - d. Immorality is a sin against God

- 1 Finally, brothers,
 we instructed you how to live
 in order to please God,
 as in fact you are living.
 Now we ask you
 and urge you in the Lord Jesus
 to do this more and more.
- 2 For you know what instructions we gave you by the authority of the Lord Jesus.
- 3 It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality;
- 4 That each of you should learn to control his own body in a way that is holy and honourable,
- 5 Not in passionate lust like the heathen, who do not know God;
- 6 And that in this matter
 no one should wrong his brother
 or take advantage of him.
 The Lord will punish men
 for all such sins,
 as we have already told you
 and warned you.
- 7 For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.
- 8 Therefore, he who rejects this instruction does not reject man but God, who gives you his Holy Spirit.
