The First Duty of the Church: Pray 1 Timothy 02:01–08

1 Pray for everyone

- a. By requests
- b. By special prayers
- c. By intercession
- d. By thanksgiving

2 Pray for civil authorities

- a. That we may lead quiet and peaceable lives
- b. That we may lead godly and holy lives

3 Pray for all men to be saved

- a. Because God is our Saviour and He wills for all men to be saved
- b. Because there is only one God, not the many gods of men
- c. Because there is only one Mediator who can save us
- d. Because Christ is the ransom for all
- e. Because ministers are ordained or appointed to proclaim the salvation of God
- 4 Pray everywhere and pray in the right spirit

- I urge, then,first of all,that requests, prayers, intercessionand thanksgiving be made for everyone —
- 2 For kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness.
- 3 This is good and pleases God our Saviour,
- 4 Who wants all men to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.
- 5 For there is one God and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus,
- 6 Who gave himself as a ransom for all menthe testimony given in its proper time.
- 7 And for this purpose
 I was appointed a herald and an apostle —
 I am telling the truth,
 I am not lying
 and a teacher of the true faith to the Gentiles.
- 8 I want men everywhere to lift up holy hands in prayer, without anger or disputing.

The Women of the Church 1 Timothy 02:09–15

- 1 In public, women are to dress modestly
 - a. Dress modestly and sensibly
 - b. Do not dress to attract attention
 - c. Dress with good deeds
- 2 In church, women are to learn in silence and submissiveness
- 3 In church, women are not to teach nor to have authority over a man
 - a. Because God created in an orderly way
 - b. Because God created man and woman with different natures
 - c. Because woman was deceived
- 4 In the home, that is, in childbearing, women are to be saved if they continue to live and walk in the Lord

- 9 I also want women to dress modestly, with decency and propriety, not with braided hair or gold or pearls or expensive clothes,
- 10 But with good deeds, appropriate for women who profess to worship God.
- 11 A woman should learn in quietness and full submission.
- 12 I do not permit a woman to teach or to have authority over a man; she must be silent.
- 13 For Adam was formed first, then Eve.
- 14 And Adam was not the one deceived; it was the woman who was deceived and became a sinner.
- 15 But women will be saved through childbearingif they continue in faith, loveand holiness with propriety.
