 - a. Believers are being built into a spiritual house

 - c. Believers are a fulfilment of prophecy

3 Picture 3: Unbelievers are disobedient builders

- a. They disqualify the stone
- b. Christ is made the Head of the corner anyway
- c. They stumble and fall over the stone
- d. The reason: They disobey the message, the Word

- 4 As you come to him, the living Stone
