- 1 The charge to add "these things" to one's life
 - a. Add goodness
 - b. Add knowledge
 - c. Add self-control
 - d. Add perseverance
 - e. Add godliness
 - f. Add brotherly kindness
 - g. Add Love
- 2 The great power of "these things"
 - a. These things keep you from being barren or unfruitful
 - b. These things keep you from being spiritually blind
 - c. These things keep you from forgetting that you have been cleansed from your sins
 - d. These things keep you from falling
 - e. These things give you eternal life and more

- 5 For this very reason, make every effort to add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge;
- 6 And to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance. godliness;
- 7 And to godliness, brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness, love.
- 8 For if you possess these qualities in increasing measure, they will keep you from being ineffective and unproductive in your knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 9 But if anyone does not have them, he is nearsighted and blind, and has forgotten that he has been cleansed from his past sins.
- 10 Therefore, my brothers, be all the more eager to make your calling and election sure. For if you do these things, you will never fall,
- 11 And you will receive a rich welcome into the eternal kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

- 3 The great importance of "these things"
 - a. To always preach these things
 - 1) Not to neglect them
 - 2) To preach them although believers are grounded therein
 - b. To always stir believers about these things, as long as you are alive
 - c. To see that believers are stirred over these things even after your death
 - 1) To die soon
 - 2) To have a lasting ministry is essential

- 12 So I will always remind you of these things, even though you know them and are firmly established in the truth you now have.
- 13 I think it is right to refresh your memory as long as I live in the tent of this body,
- 14 Because I know that I will soon put it aside, as our Lord Jesus Christ has made clear to me.
- 15 And I will make every effort to see that after my departure you will always be able to remember these things.
