2. *God was her Saviour*

47 And my spirit rejoices in God my Saviour.

a. Had considered her low estate

48 For he has been mindful
of the humble state of his servant.

b. Causes her to be remembered

From now on
all generations will call me blessed,

3. *God was to be proclaimed*

49 For the Mighty One has done
great things for me —
holy is his name.

a. His power

b. His holiness

c. His m.ercy

50 His mercy extends to those who fear him,
from generation to generation.

**4. *God had reversed
the order of things on earth***

51 He has performed mighty deeds with his arm;
he has scattered those who are proud
in their inmost thoughts.

a. Had scattered the proud

b. Had dethroned the mighty
and exalted the humble

52 He has brought down rulers from their thrones
but has lifted up the humble.

c. Had filled the hungry
and emptied the rich

53 He has filled the hungry with good things
but has sent the rich away empty.

5. *God had helped His people*

54 He has helped his servant Israel,
remembering to be merciful

a. Remembered His mercy

b. Remembered promise
to send the Messiah

55 To Abraham and his descendants forever,
even as he said to our fathers.”
