## Jesus Calls His First Disciples: Steps to Calling Men

Luke 05: 01-11

(Mt. 4:18-22; Mk. 1:16-20; Jn. 1:35-51)

- 1 Lake Gennesaret
- 2 Step 1: Seeing a vision of people who need to hear the Word of God
- 3 Step 2: Seizing resources
  - a. Seeing the resources available
  - b. Seeing a man: Simon
  - c. Leading the man to serve
- 4 Step 3: Removing reluctant obedience

- 5 Step 4: Demonstrating godly power
  - a. A great catch made
  - b. A catch so great the net breaks
  - c. A catch so great other help is needed
  - d. A catch so great both boats are filled
  - e. A catch so great the boats began to sink
- 6 Step 5: Stirring a deep confession
  - a. Of sin, v.8
  - b. Of Christ as Lord, v.8
  - c. Of awe reverence fear
- 7 Step 6: Challenging men to discipleship, that is, to catch other men
- 8 Step 7: Watching for the decision to forsake all

- 1 One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, with the people crowding around him and listening to the word of God,
- 2 He saw at the water's edge two boats, left there by the fishermen, who were washing their nets.
- 3 He got into one of the boats, the one belonging to Simon, and asked him to put out a little from shore.

  Then he sat down and taught the people from the boat.
- 4 When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch."
- 5 Simon answered, "Master, we've worked hard all night and haven't caught anything. But because you say so, I will let down the nets."
- 6 When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break.
- 7 So they signalled their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.
- 8 When Simon Peter saw this,he fell at Jesus' knees and said,"Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!"
- 9 For he and all his companions were astonished at the catch of fish they had taken,
- 10 And so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners.Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will catch men."
- 11 So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him.
