Titus 03:01–02

1 *He is to obey the laws*

2 *He is to do good works*

3 *He is not to speak evil*

4 *He is to be peaceable*

5 *He is to be gentle*

6 *He is to show humility*

1 Remind the people
to be subject to rulers and authorities,
to be obedient,
to be ready to do whatever is good,

2 To slander no one,
to be peaceable
and considerate,
and to show true humility
toward all men.

Message 4: Life Without God
Titus 03:03

1 *Man is foolish, disobedient
and deceived*

2 *Man is a slave of passions
and pleasures*

3 *Man lives in malice and envy*

4 *Man is hateful and hated*

3 At one time
we too were foolish,
disobedient, deceived
and enslaved by all kinds of passions
and pleasures.
We lived in malice and envy,
being hated and hating one another.

Message 5: Life With God; Salvation

Titus 03:04–07

1. *Salvation comes from God*

- a. From God's kindness
- b. From God's love
- c. Not by good works,
the righteous things we do
- d. By God's mercy

**2. *Salvation is a rebirth
and renewal
by God's Spirits***

**3. *Salvation comes
through Jesus Christ
our Saviour***

- a. He gives the Spirit
- b. He justifies by His grace
- c. He makes us
heirs of eternal life

4 But when the kindness
and love of God our Saviour appeared,

5 He saved us,
not because of righteous things
we had done,
but because of his mercy.

He saved us
through the washing of rebirth
and renewal
by the Holy Spirit,
