- 2. There is peace with God
- 3. There is access into the grace, the favour, and the presence of God
- 4. There is hope for the glory of God
- 5. There is glory in trials and sufferings
 - a. Trials stir perseverance
 - b. Perseverance stirs character
 - c. Character stirs hope
 - d. Hope never disappoints
- 6. There is the continuous experience of God's love through the indwelling Spirit

- 1 Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 2 Through whom
 we have gained access by faith
 into this grace
 in which we now stand.
 And we rejoice
 in the hope of the glory of God.
- 3 Not only so, but we also rejoice in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;
- 4 Perseverance, character; and character, hope.
- 5 And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.
