The Warning Example of Israel 1 Corinthians 10:01–13

1 The example of Israel: All shared the blessings of God

- a. The blessings
 - 1) Cloud (guidance)
 - 2) Sea (deliverance)
 - 3) The baptism into Moses (leadership)
 - 4) Food and water (spiritual nourishment)
 - 5) The presence of Christ
- b. The displeasure of God:Some were rejectedperished in the desert

2 The warning

- a. Crave not evil things
 - as they did
- b. Be not idolaters
 - as some of them were
- c. Commit no immorality
 - as some of them committed
- d. Try not the Lord's patience
 - as some of them tried it
- e. Complain not
 - as some of them complained

- 1 For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers, that our forefathers were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea.
- 2 They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea.
- 3 They all ate the same spiritual food
- 4 And drank the same spiritual drink; for they drank from the spiritual rock that accompanied them, and that rock was Christ.
- Nevertheless,God was not pleased with most of them;their bodies were scattered over the desert.
- 6 Now these things occurred as examples to keep us from setting our hearts on evil things as they did.
- 7 Do not be idolaters, as some of them were; as it is written:
 - "The people sat down to eat and drink and got up to indulge in pagan revelry."
- 8 We should not commit sexual immorality, as some of them did
 - and in one daytwenty-three thousand of them died.
- 9 We should not test the Lord, as some of them did
 - and were killed by snakes.
- 10 And do not grumble, as some of them did
 - and were killed by the destroying angel.

3 The point: Receive the warning

- a. The climax of the age has come
- b. Fear, if you think you stand, lest you fall
- c. Know the way to escape temptation
 - 1) No temptation is unique; all temptation is common to all men
 - 2) God limits temptation
 - 3) God provides an escape

- 11 These things happened to them as examples and were written down as warnings for us, on whom the fulfilment of the ages has come.
- 12 So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall!
- 13 No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
