1 Their origin: Everywhere

- a. All nations and tribes
- b. All peoples and languages

2 Their glorious position

- a. Before the throne and the Lamb
- b. Clothed in white
- c. Holding palm branches
- d. Shouting praise for their salvation

3 Their glorious companions

- a. The companions' identity:
 The angels, the elders,
 the four creatures
- b. The function of the companions: To praise God for saving believers out of the tribulation

4 Their identity:
An elder asks John
for the people's identity

- 9 After this I looked and there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb.

 They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands.
- 10 And they cried out in a loud voice: "Salvation belongs to our God, who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb."
- 11 All the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures. They fell down on their faces before the throne and worshiped God,

12 Saying:

"Amen!

Praise and glory and wisdom and thanks and honour and power and strength be to our God for ever and ever. Amen!"

13 Then one of the elders asked me,
"These in white robes —
who are they,
and where did they come from?"

- a. They are people out of the great tribulation
- b. They have washed their robes in the Lamb's blood
- 5 Their function: To serve God continuously
- 6 Their blessings: Bliss
 - a. They will have God's presenceforever
 - b. They will have their physical needs met
 - c. They will be protected
 - d. They will have their spiritual needs met
 - e. They will be led to the fountain of life
 - f. Their sorrow will be wiped away

- 14 I answered, "Sir, you know."

 And he said,
 "These are they
 who have come out of the great tribulation;
 they have washed their robes
 and made them white
 in the blood of the Lamb.
- 15 Therefore,

"they are before the throne of God and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will spread his tent over them.

- 16 Never again will they hunger; never again will they thirst.The sun will not beat upon them, nor any scorching heat.
- 17 For the Lamb at the centre of the throne will be their shepherd;
 he will lead them to springs of living water.
 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes."
