The Strong Believer and the Weak Believer: Questionable Functions and Behaviour — Christian Liberty Romans 14:10-23

1. Leave the judgment up to God

- a. Because everyone will be judged by Christ
- 10 You, then. why do you judge your brother? Or why do you look down on your brother? For we will all stand before God's judgment seat.
- b. Because every knee will bow and confess that Christ alone is God
- c. Because everyone will give
- an account of himself to God
- 2. Judge only one thing: Stumbling blocks
 - a. By watching the things that people think are unclean
 - b. By acting in love: Not hurting, wounding, ruining others
- 3. Give no occasion for criticism
 - a. Because the Kingdom of God is the believer's concern, not pleasure

11 It is written:

"As surely as I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee will bow before me; every tongue will confess to God.""

- 12 So then, each of us will give an account of himself to God.
- 13 Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in your brother's way.
- 14 As one who is in the Lord Jesus, I am fully convinced that no food is unclean in itself. But if anyone regards something as unclean, then for him it is unclean.
- 15 If your brother is distressed because of what you eat, you are no longer acting in love. Do not by your eating destroy your brother for whom Christ died.
- 16 Do not allow what you consider good to be spoken of as evil.
- 17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit,

- b. Because serving Christ and the Kingdom of God pleases God and men
- 4. Pursue things that bring peace and edification
- 5. Do not destroy or ruin the work of God in another person's life: It is sin to do so
- 6. Do nothing to cause a brother to fall
- 7. Watch and do not condemn yourself
 - a. By keeping your faith
 - b. By not going against conscience
 - c. By acting on faith, from a conviction that God approves your behaviour

- 18 Because anyone who serves Christ in this way is pleasing to God and approved by men.
- 19 Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification.
- 20 Do not destroy the work of God for the sake of food.All food is clean,but it is wrong for a man to eat anything that causes someone else to stumble.
- 21 It is better not to eat meat or drink wine or to do anything else that will cause your brother to fall.
- 22 So whatever you believe about these things keep between yourself and God.Blessed is the man who does not condemn himself by what he approves.
- 23 But the man who has doubts is condemned if he eats, because his eating is not from faith; and everything that does not come from faith is sin.
