The First Sermon (Part II): Proofs of the Resurrection Acts 02:25–36

1 *Proof 1*:

The prophecy of David – concerned Jesus

- a. Jesus' daily life
 - 1) He had God's constant presence
 - 2) He rejoiced and praised God
 - 3) He lives in hope and trust
- b. Jesus' conviction: God's deliverance
 - 1) Not left in hell
 - 2) Not see decay
- c. Jesus' revelation:The path of life —God's presence

2 Proof 2: Peter's testimony

- a. David's prophecy could not refer to David
- b. The prophecy referred to Jesus:
 His resurrection
 - 1) Raised to reign with God
 - 2) Raised to deliver His soul from hell or the grave
 - 3) Raised to deliver His body from decay

3 Proof 3: The eye-witnesses the disciples

25 David said about him:

'I saw the Lord always before me. Because he is at my right hand, I will not be shaken.

- 26 Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue rejoices; my body also will live in hope,
- 27 Because you will not abandon me to the grave, nor will you let your Holy One see decay.
- 28 You have made known to me the paths of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence.'
- 29 "Brothers,
 I can tell you confidently
 that the patriarch David died
 and was buried,
 and his tomb is here to this day.
- 30 But he was a prophet and knew that God had promised him on oath that he would place one of his descendants on his throne.
- 31 Seeing what was ahead, he spoke of the resurrection of the Christ, that he was not abandoned to the grave, nor did his body see decay.
- 32 God has raised this Jesus to life, and we are all witnesses of the fact.

4 Proof 4: The exaltation and the ascension of Jesus into heaven

- a. Jesus was raised to be exalted
- b. David prophesied the Lord's exaltation

c. Jesus was made both Lord and Messiah

- 33 Exalted to the right hand of God, he has received from the Father the promised Holy Spirit and has poured out what you now see and hear.
- 34 For David did not ascend to heaven, and yet he said,'The Lord said to my Lord:Sit at my right hand
- 35 Until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet.'
- 36 Therefore let all Israel be assured of this:
 God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ."
