The Armour of the Christian Soldier Ephesians 06:10–20

1 The soldier's charge

- a. Be strong in the Lordin His mighty power
- b. Put on the full armour of God
- 2 The soldier's enemy: The devil and his strategies
- 3 The soldier's warfare: Not human, but spiritual
- 4 The soldier's duty:
 To take the full armour of God
 - a. That he may resist in the day of evil
 - b. That he may stand
- 5 The soldier's armour
 - a. The belt of truth
 - b. The breastplate of righteousness
 - c. The sandals of the gospel
 - d. The shield of faith
 - e. The helmet of salvation
 - f. The sword of the Spirit

10 Finally, be strong in the Lord

and in his mighty power.

- 11 Put on the full armour of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes.
- 12 For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms.
- 13 Therefore
 put on the full armour of God,
 so that when the day of evil comes,
 you may be able to stand your ground,
 and after you have done everything,
 to stand.
- 14 Stand firm then,
 with the belt of truth
 buckled around your waist,
 with the breastplate of righteousness in place,
- 15 And with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace.
- 16 In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one.
- 17 Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

6 The supernatural provision: Prayer — always praying

- a. With all kinds of prayer
- b. In the Spirit
- c. Being alert
- d. For all saints and for ministers in particular
- 18 And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the saints.
- 19 Pray also for me, that whenever I open my mouth, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel,
- 20 For which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should.

The Examples of Faithful Christian Soldiers Ephesians 06:21–24

1. There was the soldier Tychicus

- a. A beloved brother
- b. A faithful minister
- c. A friend of believers, a messenger of encouragement
- 21 Tychicus, the dear brother and faithful servant in the Lord, will tell you everything, so that you also may know how I am and what I am doing.
- 22 I am sending him to you for this very purpose, that you may know how we are, and that he may encourage you.

2. There was the soldier Paul

- a. A spiritual brother:Concerned for the peace,love and faith of others
- b. A prayer warrior:Prayed that God's grace would rest upon others
- 23 Peace to the brothers, and love with faith from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 24 Grace to all who love our Lord Jesus Christ with an undying love.
