## The Great Wedding Supper of the Lamb, of the Lord Jesus Christ

Revelation 19:01–10

### 1 The Wedding Supper will be a supper of glorious praise

- a. It will be an hallelujah of salvation
- b. It will be an hallelujah of victory

- c. It will be an hallelujah of worship
- d. It will be an hallelujah of God's omnipotent reign

- 1 After this I heard what sounded like the roar of a great multitude in heaven shouting: "Hallelujah! Salvation and glory and power belong to our God,
- 2 For true and just are his judgments. He has condemned the great prostitute who corrupted the earth by her adulteries. He has avenged on her the blood of his servants."
- 3 And again they shouted: "Hallelujah! The smoke from her goes up for ever and ever."
- 4 The twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God, who was seated on the throne. And they cried: " Amen, Hallelujah!"
- 5 Then a voice came from the throne, saying: "Praise our God, all you his servants, you who fear him, both small and great!"
- 6 Then I heard what sounded like a great multitude, like the roar of rushing waters and like loud peals of thunder, shouting: "Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns.

- 2 The Wedding Supper will focus upon the Lamb
- 3 The Wedding Supper will have a pure and prepared Bride
  - a. The bride, the church, prepares herself
  - b. The bride, the church, does righteous deeds
- 4 The Wedding Supper will be a blessed and glorious event
  - a. It will be blessed because of all those invited to the supper
  - b. It will be blessed because it is for the worship of God alone

- 7 Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory!For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready.
- 8 Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear."
  (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of the saints.)
- 9 Then the angel said to me,
  "Write: 'Blessed are those
  who are invited
  to the wedding supper of the Lamb!"
  And he added,
  "These are the true words of God."
- 10 At this I fell at his feet to worship him.

  But he said to me, "Do not do it!

  I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers who hold to the testimony of Jesus.

  Worship God!

  For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy."

# The Coming of Christ As Conqueror Revelation 19:11–16

#### 1 The conquering Christ

- a. He will sit on a white horse
- b. He will judge with justice

#### 2 The consuming Prince

- a. His eyes are as fire
- b. His head is crowned
- c. His name is secret
- 3 The slaughtering Word of God: Clothed in blood
- 4 The heavenly, warring Leader: Heavenly armies follow

#### 5 The fierce Conqueror

- a. He will have a weapon:The sword of His mouth —His Word
- b. He will strike and rule the nations
- c. He will execute fierce wrath
- 6 The King of kings and Lord of lords: A revealed name

- 11 I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war.
- 12 His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no one knows but he himself.
- 13 He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God.
- 14 The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean.
- 15 Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations."He will rule them with an iron sceptre."He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty.
- 16 On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written:

  KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
