- 2 There was man obeying
- 3 There was the spirit of being together in one mind
- 4 There was the Spirit's infilling
  - a. As a mighty sound —as the blowingof a "violent" wind
  - b. As fire as split tongues that rested on each believer

    - 1) All were filled with the Spirit
    - 2) All spoke in other tongues— witnessing
- 5 There was witnessing God-fearing men heard
  - a. Heard in their "own language"

b. Heard in their "own native language"

- 1 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.
- 2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting.
- 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them.
- 4 All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them.
- 5 Now there were staying in Jerusalem God-fearing Jews from every nation under heaven.
- 6 When they heard this sound, a crowd came together in bewilderment, because each one heard them speaking in his own language.
- 7 Utterly amazed, they asked:"Are not all these men who are speaking Galileans?
- 8 Then how is it that each of us hears them in his own native language?

- 9 Parthians, Medes and Elamites;residents of Mesopotamia,Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia.
- 10 Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya near Cyrene; visitors from Rome
- 11 (Both Jews and converts to Judaism);Cretans and Arabs —we hear them declaring the wonders of God in our own tongues!"
- 12 Amazed and perplexed, they asked one another, "What does this mean?"
- 13 Some, however,made fun of them and said,"They have had too much wine."
