<p>1 <i>God's power: A great power</i></p> <p>a. In believers</p> <p>b. Measured by God's power in Christ exalted</p>	<p>19 And his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like the working of his mighty strength,</p>
<p>2 <i>The power that raised Him from the dead</i></p>	<p>20 Which he exerted in Christ when he raised him from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms.</p>
<p>3 <i>The power that took Him to heaven and seated Him at God's right hand</i></p>	
<p>4 <i>The power that exalted Christ above all creatures: In this age and in the next age</i></p>	<p>21 Far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come.</p>
<p>5 <i>The power that exalted Him as the Supreme Head of the church</i></p> <p>a. Christ — the Head</p> <p>b. The church — His body</p> <p>c. The church — His instrument</p>	<p>22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for the church,</p> <p>23 Which is his body, the fullness of him who fills everything in every way.</p>
