## Jesus Commissions His Disciples Luke 09:01–09

(Mt. 9:35-10:42; Mk. 6:7-13)

1	Their call:
	To come together for ministry

- 2 Their equipment: Power and authority
- 3 Their mission: To preach and minister

## 4 Their method

- a. Not to seek success through personal appearance and materialism
- b. To minister in the homes, to the interested and the hospitable
- c. To warn rejecters
- 5 Their obedience: They went forth preaching and ministering

## 6 Their effect

- a. Herod was disturbed by their message
- b. The people speculated about Jesus' identity
- c. Herod desired to know Jesus' identity

- 1 When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases,
- 2 And he sent them out to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.
- 3 He told them:

  "Take nothing for the journey —
  no staff, no bag, no bread,
  no money, no extra tunic.
- 4 Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that town.
- 5 If people do not welcome you, shake the dust off your feet when you leave their town, as a testimony against them."
- 6 So they set out and went from village to village, preaching the gospel and healing people everywhere.
- Now Herod the tetrarch heard about all that was going on.And he was perplexed, because some were saying that John had been raised from the dead,
- 8 Others that Elijah had appeared, and still others that one of the prophets of long ago had come back to life.
- 9 But Herod said, "I beheaded John. Who, then, is this I hear such things about?" And he tried to see him.
