Herod desired to know Jesus' identity	<p>1 When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all demons and to cure diseases,</p> <p>2 And he sent them out to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.</p> <p>3 He told them: “Take nothing for the journey — no staff, no bag, no bread, no money, no extra tunic.</p> <p>4 Whatever house you enter, stay there until you leave that town.</p> <p>5 If people do not welcome you, shake the dust off your feet when you leave their town, as a testimony against them.”</p> <p>6 So they set out and went from village to village, preaching the gospel and healing people everywhere.</p> <p>7 Now Herod the tetrarch heard about all that was going on. And he was perplexed, because some were saying that John had been raised from the dead,</p> <p>8 Others that Elijah had appeared, and still others that one of the prophets of long ago had come back to life.</p> <p>9 But Herod said, “I beheaded John. Who, then, is this I hear such things about?” And he tried to see him.</p>
