- 13 But we ought always to thank God for you, brothers
 loved by the Lord,
 because from the beginning

- 14 He called you to this through our gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 15 So then, brothers,stand firm and hold to the teachingswe passed on to you,whether by word of mouth or by letter.
