1 His faith:

A faith that obeyed God

- b. The great faith of Abraham
 - 1) A decisive, obedient faith:
Obeyed God's call
 - 2) A hopeful, obedient faith:
Continued to follow God —
as a pilgrim

2 His reward:

The hope that looked for a heavenly city

- 8 By faith Abraham,
when called to go to a place
he would later receive as his inheritance,
obeyed and went,
even though he did not know
where he was going.
- 9 By faith he made his home in the promised land
like a stranger in a foreign country;
he lived in tents,
as did Isaac and Jacob,
who were heirs with him of the same promise.
- 10 For he was looking forward
to the city with foundations,
whose architect and builder is God.
