1 The purpose of judgment: To rectify injustice

2 The executor of judgment: Jesus Christ Himself

- a. A spectacular appearance from heaven
- b. With angels
- c. In flaming fire

3 The people to be judged

- a. All who do not know God
- b. All who disobey the gospel

4 The penalty of judgment

- a. Punishment and destruction
- b. Separation from the Lord

5 The time of judgment

- a. When He comes to be glorified in His holy people
- b. When He comes to be marvelled at

6 The escape from judgment

- a. God must count a person worthy to escape
- b. God must complete the work of faith in a person
- c. The name of Christ must be glorified in a person

6 God is just:He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you

- 7 And give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well.This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels.
- 8 He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
- 9 They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power
- 10 On the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marvelled at among all those who have believed.This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you.
- 11 With this in mind,
 we constantly pray for you,
 that our God may count you worthy of his calling,
 and that by his power
 he may fulfil every good purpose of yours
 and every act prompted by your faith.
- 12 We pray this so that the name of our Lord Jesus may be glorified in you, and you in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.
