Believers will suffer persecution</p> <p>3 Mark 3: <i>Guarding against evil men and imposters</i></p>	<p>10 You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance,</p> <p>11 Persecutions, sufferings - what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them.</p> <p>12 In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted,</p> <p>13 While evil men and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived.</p>

<p>1 A believer must live in the Scripture</p> <p>2 Scripture makes a person wise for salvation</p> <p>3 Scripture is God-breathed inspired by God</p> <p>4 Scripture is profitable to man</p> <p>5 Scripture equips a man for every good work</p>	<p>14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it,</p> <p>15 And how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.</p> <p>16 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,</p> <p>17 So that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.</p>
