

**The Future Glory of Jerusalem:
A Picture of the Holy City During
the Messiah’s Kingdom on Earth — the Millennium
Isaiah 60:01–10**

1. *The Holy City will receive the light and the glory of God’s presence (v. 14): in Jesus Christ, Jn. 8:12*

- a. The darkness presently covers the earth: Bondage, oppression, evil, disease, death
- b. The lord’s glory will rise over the Holy City: To rescue it
- c. The LORD’s light, in the person of Jesus Christ, will draw all nations to Jerusalem. Jn. 8:12; Rev 21:23
 - 1) All the Gentiles
 - 2) All the Jews

2. *The Holy City will be the centre of world trade and of worship*

- a. The centre of world trade
 - 1) The commerce of the seas — the entire earth — will be centred in Jerusalem
 - 2) The products transported by land will have their headquarters in Jerusalem
- b. The centre of worship
 - 1) The people of all nations will worship and praise the LORD
 - 2) The nations will present offerings to the LORD
 - lie will accept their gifts
 - He will glorify, adorn His temple with their worship

- 1 “Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD rises upon you.
- 2 See, darkness covers the earth and thick darkness is over the peoples, but the LORD rises upon you and his glory appears over you.
- 3 Nations will come to your light, and kings to the brightness of your dawn.
- 4 “Lift up your eyes and look about you: All assemble and come to you; your sons come from afar, and your daughters are carried on the hip.
- 5 Then you will look and be radiant, your heart will throb and swell with joy; the wealth on the seas will be brought to you, to you the riches of the nations will come.
- 6 Herds of camels will cover your land, young camels of Midian and Ephah. And all from Sheba will come, bearing gold and incense and proclaiming the praise of the LORD.
- 7 All Kedar’s flocks will be gathered to you, the rams of Nebaioth will serve you; they will be accepted as offerings on my altar, and I will adorn my glorious temple.
