John 14:01-03

**1. *Delivers through trust in God and Christ***

1 "Do not let your hearts be troubled.  
Trust in God; trust also in me.

**2. *Delivers through the hope for God's house and its rooms or mansions***

2 In my Father's house are many rooms;  
if it were not so,  
I would have told you.  
I am going there to prepare a place for you.

**3. *Delivers through the work of Christ***

**4. *Delivers through the return of Christ***

3 And if I go and prepare a place for you,  
I will come back  
and take you to be with me  
that you also may be where I am.

**5. *Delivers through living with Christ eternally***

## The Way to God Is by Jesus Alone

John 14: 04-07

**1. *The declaration of Jesus: He was going to God***

- a. The way to God is known
- b. The contradiction  
and skepticism of Thomas

4 "You know the way to the place  
where I am going."

5 Thomas said to him, "Lord, we don't know  
where you are going,  
so how can we know the way?"

**2. *The way to God is through Jesus Christ Himself***

6 Jesus answered,  
"I am the way and the truth and the life.  
No one comes to the Father  
except through me.

**3. *The only way to God is through Jesus Christ***

**4. *The only way to God is now unmistakably revealed: To know Christ is to know God***

7 If you really knew me,  
you would know my Father as well.  
From now on,  
you do know him and have seen him."

## The Embodiment of God Is Jesus Himself

John 14: 08-14

**1. *The request of Philip: Show us the Father, some dazzling sight***

8 Philip said, "Lord, show us the Father  
and that will be enough for us."

**2. *The revelation: Jesus is the full embodiment of God***

9 Jesus answered: "Don't you know me, Philip,  
even after I have been among you such a long time?  
Anyone who has seen me has seen the Father.  
How can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

Will receive anything if ask in Jesus' name</li> </ul>	<p>10 Don't you believe that I am in the Father, and that the Father is in me? The words I say to you are not just my own. Rather, it is the Father, living in me, who is doing his work.</p> <p>11 Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves.</p> <p>12 I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.</p> <p>13 And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Son may bring glory to the Father.</p> <p>14 You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it.</p>
