The Young Minister (Charge 4): To Be a Man of God 1 Timothy 06:11–16

- 1 Flee the passion for wealth (cp. v. 9-10).
- 2 Pursue, follow after the things of God
- 3 Fight the fight of faith and lay hold of eternal life
 - a. Are called to eternity
 - b. Have witnessed to eternity
- 4 Keep this charge keep this commandment (v. 14)
 - a. Because of God's power to quicken, to give life
 - b. Because of Christ's example
 - c. Because Christ is to come again:
 He is to be exalted
 as King of kings
 and Lord of lords
 - d. Because Christ alone possesses immortality:He dwells in the transcendent
 - e. Because Christ alone possesses an unapproachable light of God's great glory

- 11 But you, man of God, flee from all this, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.
- 12 Fight the good fight of the faith.

 Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.
- 13 In the sight of God,
 who gives life to everything,
 and of Christ Jesus,
 who while testifying before Pontius Pilate
 made the good confession,
 I charge you
- 14 To keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 15 Which God will bring about in his own time God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords,
- 16 Who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see.To him be honour and might forever.Amen.
