## The First Consequences of Sin: Man's Tragic Fall from Perfection Genesis 03:07–13

- The sense of being naked —
   of being imperfect and short of
   God's glory and righteousness
- 2. The attempt to cover sin
- 3. The running away and hiding from God
- 4. The alienation from God and the breaking of God's heart
- 5. The disturbed relationships and the severe divisions caused by sin
  - a. Sin disturbs man's relationship with God
  - b. Sin disturbs man's relationship with others and causes a division between him and others
  - 1) Adam blamed Eve
  - 2) Adam blamed God
  - 3) Eve blamed the serpent, the devil

- 7 Then the eyes of both of them were opened, and they realized they were naked; so they sewed fig leaves together and made coverings for themselves.
- 8 Then the man and his wife heard the sound of the LORD God as he was walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and they hid from the Lord God among the trees of the garden.
- 9 But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"
- 10 He answered, "I heard you in the garden, and I was afraid because I was naked; so I hid."
- 11 And he said,
  "Who told you that you were naked?
  Have you eaten from the tree
  that I commanded you not to eat from?"
- 12 The man said,
  "The woman you put here with me—
  she gave me some fruit from the tree,
  and I ate it."
- 13 Then the Lord God said to the woman, "What is this you have done?"

  The woman said,
  "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

## The First Judgment upon Sin (Part 1): Judgment upon the Tempter, That Old Serpent Called the Devil Genesis 03:14–15

- 1. He was cursed above all creatures
- 2. He was to crawl upon his belly, that is, to be detested, degraded, and miserable always
- 3. He was to eat dust:

  To be defeated and humiliated—
  always
- 4. He was to be the object of enmity enmity was to be waged between him and the woman and her seed
- 5. He was to be crushed by one particular seed or descendant of the woman

- 14 So the LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done this, Cursed are you above all livestock and all wild animals!

  You will crawl on your belly and you will eat dust all the days of your life.
- 15 And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."

## The First Provision of God for Man: God Provides Life and Clothing (Righteousness) for Man Genesis 03:20–21

- 1. Adam names the woman, Eve: He believes God's provision for birth and life
- 2. God provides clothing for man and woman, clothing through sacrifice
- 20 Adam named his wife Eve, because she would become the mother of all the living.
- 21 The LORD God made garments of skin for Adam and his wife and clothed them.
