The Renewal of the Covenant Between God and Man: The Steps to Renewal Exodus 34:01–09

`1.Step 1 — Responding to God's call to come back into His presence

- a. To prepare to receive a second copy of God's law, His Word:
 To chisel two stone tablets
- b. To meet God in the morning on Mt. Sinai: The very special place of God's presence
- c. To meet God alone:No person, not even an animal,was to be present to distract
- d. God's servant responded and obeyed:Did everything God said
- 2. Step 2 Seeking and experiencing God's presence afresh
 - a. God revealed Himself and proclaimed His name
 - 1) He is the LORD, the LORD
 - 2) He is merciful and gracious
 - 3) He is slow to anger
 - 4) He abounds in love and is faithful

- 1 The LORD said to Moses,
 "Chisel out two stone tablets
 like the first ones,
 and I will write on them
 the words that were on the first tablets,
 which you broke.
- 2 Be ready in the morning, and then come up on Mount Sinai. Present yourself to me there on top of the mountain.
- 3 No one is to come with you or be seen anywhere on the mountain; not even the flocks and herds may graze in front of the mountain."
- 4 So Moses chiselled out two stone tablets like the first ones and went up Mount Sinai early in the morning, as the Lord had commanded him; and he carried the two stone tablets in his hands.
- 5 Then the LORD came down in the cloud and stood there with him and proclaimed his name, the LORD.
- 6 And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and faithfulness

- 5) He shows love to thousands by forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin
- 6) He executes righteousness and justice: He punishes the guilty and the children of the guilty
- b. Moses bowed and worshipped and prayed
- 1) For God's guidance
- 2) For God's forgiveness
- 3) For God to accept His people as His very special possession and inheritance

- 7 maintaining love to thousands, and forgiving wickedness, rebellion and sin. Yet he does not leave the guilty unpunished; he punishes the children and their children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation."
- 8 Moses bowed to the ground at once and worshipped.
- 9 "Lord," he said,
 "if I have found favour in your eyes,
 then let the Lord go with us.
 Although this is a stiff-necked people,
 forgive our wickedness and our sin,
 and take us as your inheritance."
