Warning Three (Part I): The Danger of Immaturity or of Falling Away Hebrews 05:11–06:03

- 1 A person becomes immature because he is slow to learn
- 2 *A person becomes immature because he refuses to grow*
- 3 A person becomes immature because he is not acquainted with the Word
- 4 A person becomes immature because he does not train his mental & spiritual senses
- 5 A person needs to get past the ABC's of teaching

6 A person must be determined to grow in Christ

- 11 We have much to say about this, but it is hard to make it clear to you because you no longer try to understand.
- 12 In fact,though by this time you ought to be teachers,you need someone to teach youthe elementary truths of God's wordall over again.You need milk, not solid food!
- 13 Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness.
- 14 But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.

CHAPTER 6

- Therefore let us move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ and be taken forward to maturity, not laying again the foundation of repentance from acts that lead to death, and of faith in God,
- 2 instruction about cleansing rites, the laying on of hands, the resurrection of the dead, and eternal judgment.
- 3 And God permitting, we will do so.
