Preaching Peace  
Acts 10:34–43**

**1 *God shows no favouritism***  
**– *He accepts anyone***  
***who fears Him***  
***and does what is right***

34 Then Peter began to speak:  
“I now realize how true it is  
that God does not show favouritism

35 But accepts men from every nation  
who fear him  
and do what is right.

**2 *God sent His Word to Israel;***  
***He sent Jesus Christ***  
***preaching peace***

36 You know the message God  
sent to the people of Israel,  
telling the good news of peace  
through Jesus Christ,  
who is Lord of all.

a. He is Lord of all

b. He has been talked about  
and the news has been  
spread all around

37 You know what has happened  
throughout Judea,  
beginning in Galilee  
after the baptism that John preached –

c. He began in Galilee  
after John’s ministry

**3 *Jesus is God’s anointed Saviour***

38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth  
with the Holy Spirit and power,  
and how he went around doing good  
and healing all who were  
under the power of the devil,  
because God was with him.

a. With the Holy Spirit

b. With miraculous power

c. The proof:  
“We are witnesses”

39 We are witnesses of everything he did  
in the country of the Jews  
and in Jerusalem.  
They killed him  
by hanging him on a tree,

**4 *Jesus was crucified***

**5 *Jesus was raised up by God***

40 But God raised him from the dead  
on the third day  
and caused him to be seen.

<p><b>6</b> <i>Jesus appeared to some who were chosen to be witnesses</i></p>	<p>41 He was not seen by all the people, but by witnesses whom God had already chosen — by us who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.</p>
<p><b>7</b> <i>Jesus shall judge the living and the dead</i></p>	<p>42 He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead.</p>
<p><b>8</b> <i>Jesus is the prophesied Messiah</i></p> <p><b>9</b> <i>Believing in Jesus brings forgiveness of sin</i></p>	<p>43 All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.”</p>

**A Worldwide Ministry in Caesarea (Part III):  
Receiving the Holy Spirit  
Acts 10:44–48**

**1 *The Holy Spirit came on the Gentiles***

- a. They “heard the Message”
- b. While Peter spoke
- c. The Jewish believers were amazed

**2 *The Gentile believers spoke in tongues and praised God***

**3 *The Gentile believers were baptised***

**4 *The door to the Gentiles was opened***

44 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit came on all who heard the message.

45 The circumcised believers who had come with Peter were astonished that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out even on the Gentiles.

46 For they heard them speaking in tongues and praising God.  
Then Peter said,

47 “Can anyone keep these people from being baptised with water? They have received the Holy Spirit just as we have.”

48 So he ordered that they be baptised in the name of Jesus Christ.  
Then they asked Peter to stay with them for a few days.
