1 It gave Paul purpose for existing

- a. He existed to be a prisoner for Christ
- b. He existed to be a steward of God's grace
- 2 It was a mystery: It required a special revelation to become known
 - a. Revealed to Paul
 - b. Revealed to others

3 It was a threefold revelation

- a. All are fellow-heirs
- b. All are of one body
- c. All share in God's promise: The new creation

4 It affected Paul – profoundly

- a. Caused himto become a ministerby the power of God
- b. Caused himto become a preacherunworthy as he was

- 1 For this reason I,Paul,the prisoner of Christ Jesusfor the sake of you Gentiles —
- 2 Surely you have heard about the administration of God's grace that was given to me for you,
- 3 That is, the mystery made known to me by revelation, as I have already written briefly.
- 4 In reading this, then, you will be able to understand my insight into the mystery of Christ,
- 5 Which was not made known to men in other generations as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to God's holy apostles and prophets.
- 6 This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.
- 7 I became a servant of this gospel by the gift of God's grace given me through the working of his power.
- 8 Although I am less than the least of all God's people, this grace was given me: to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ,

- c. Caused him to become an evangelist
- 5 It affects heavenly beings even now, profoundly so:
 Causes them to stand in stark amazement
 - a. At what God is doing in the church
 - b. At God's eternal purposein Christ
 - c. At the believer's access into God's presenceby faith
- 6 It stirred a willingness within

- 9 And to make plain to everyone the administration of this mystery, which for ages past was kept hidden in God, who created all things.
- 10 His intent was that now, through the church, the manifold wisdom of God should be made known to the rulers and authorities in the heavenly realms.
- 11 According to his eternal purpose which he accomplished in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- 12 In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.
- 13 I ask you,
 therefore,
 not to be discouraged
 because of my sufferings for you,
 which are your glory.

- 7 Request 6: For the fullness of God
- 8 Conclusion:

The encouragement to pray and trust God for the answer

- a. The fact:
 God is able
- b. The source:
 The power that works in us
- c. The purpose:That God might be glorifiedin the church through Jesus Christ

- 14 For this reason
 I kneel before the Father,
- 15 From whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name.
- 16 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,
- 17 So that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith.And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love,
- 18 May have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ,
- 19 And to know this love that surpasses knowledge that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.
- 20 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,
- 21 To him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
