## The Startling Oracles or Prophecies Pronounced by Balaam: The Blessings of God and a Glimpse into the Future Numbers 24: 14–25

## 1. The 4th prophecy: A picture of the coming Deliverer

- a. The preparation:
- Balaam started to leave, but he was constrained by God to prophesy: About the "days to come"
- 2) Balaam declared...
- that his eyes saw clearly
- that he heard the Words of God
- that he had knowledge from the Most High
- that he saw a vision from the Almighty
- that his eyes were opened
- b. The prophecy: A picture of the coming Deliverer
- 1) He will come in the future
- 2) He will be a star and a sceptre (have dominion)
- 3) He will be victorious over all enemies, Moab and Edom
- 4) He will guarantee the growing strength of His people (Israel)
- 5) He will guarantee the triumph and dominion of God's people

- 14 "Now I am going back to my people, but come, let me warn you of what this people will do to your people in days to come."
- 15 Then he spoke his message:
  "The prophecy of Balaam son of Beor,
  the prophecy of one whose eye sees clearly,
- 16 the prophecy of one
  who hears the words of God,
  who has knowledge from the Most High,
  who sees a vision from the Almighty,
  who falls prostrate,
  and whose eyes are opened:
- 17 "I see him, but not now;I behold him, but not near.A star will come out of Jacob;a sceptre will rise out of Israel.He will crush the foreheads of Moab,the skulls of all the people of Sheth.
- 18 Edom will be conquered; Seir, his enemy, will be conquered, but Israel will grow strong.
- 19 A ruler will come out of Jacob and destroy the survivors of the city."

## 2. The 5th prophecy: A picture of victory over the greatest enemies

- a Balaam saw Amalek and prophesied
- b. Amalek, the greatest of nations, would be destroyed
- 3. The 6th prophecy:
  A picture of the greatest fortresses
  of the enemy being destroyed
  - a. Balaam saw the Kenites and prophesied
  - b. The Kenites and their impregnable fortress would be destroyed by Assyria
- 4. The 7th prophecy:

  A picture of God's judgment
  against all whose "cup is full of
  iniquity" (has reached the full
  measure that God allows)
  - a. Balaam again prophesied the future
  - b. Assyria and Eberwould be destroyed:By an invading forcecoming across the sea
  - c. Balaam and Balak separated and returned home

- 20 Then Balaam saw Amalek and spoke his message:"Amalek was first among the nations, but their end will be utter destruction."
- 21 Then he saw the Kenites and spoke his message: "Your dwelling place is secure, your nest is set in a rock;
- 22 yet you Kenites will be destroyed when Ashur takes you captive."
- 23 Then he spoke his message:"Alas!Who can live when God does this?

- 24 Ships will come from the shores of Cyprus; they will subdue Ashur and Eber, but they too will come to ruin."
- 25 Then Balaam got up and returned home, and Balak went his own way.
