

They Will Walk in His Name

Zechariah 10:08–12

1. *Christ will call His people
to return to the promised land*

- 1) They will be redeemed
- 2) They will multiply
- 3) They will remember the LORD
- 4) They will survive as a people
and will always have
the hope of returning

5) They will return
from Egypt and Assyria
(representing all nations)

6) They will live in the land
promised by God to Abraham
(Gilead and Lebanon)

- 7) They will safely pass
through all obstacles
and afflictions as they return
- Assyria's pride will be crushed,
brought down
 - Egypt's rule and dominion
will come to an end

2. *Christ will strengthen
His people for one reason:
That they might walk
in His Name*

8 I will signal for them and gather them in.
Surely I will redeem them;
they will be as numerous as before.

9 Though I scatter them among the peoples,
yet in distant lands they will remember me. They
and their children will survive,
and they will return.

10 I will bring them back from Egypt
and gather them from Assyria.
I will bring them to Gilead and Lebanon,
and there will not be room enough for them.

11 They will pass through the sea of trouble;
the surging sea will be subdued
and all the depths of the Nile will dry up.
Assyria's pride will be brought down
and Egypt's sceptre will pass away.

12 I will strengthen them in the LORD
and in his name they will live securely,"
declares the LORD.
