- 1. The primary charge of God given to families: To teach children to obey His commandments
 - a. The commandments
 will teach you to fear the LORD:
 You, your children
 and grandchildren —
 all generations
 - b. The commandments will prolong your days you will enjoy a long life
 - c. The commandments will cause all things to go well: Give you a victorious life
 - d. The commandments will make you increase (grow in numbers) and assure a full, satisfying life

2. The greatest commandment

- a. The LORD our God is One LORD
- b. Love the LORD your God with your whole being heart, soul and strength

3. The duty of the parent

a. To place the commandments in your heart

- These are the commands, decrees and laws the LORD your God directed me to teach you to observe in the land that you are crossing the Jordan to possess,
- 2 so that you, your children and their children after them may fear the LORD your God as long as you live by keeping all his decrees and commands that I give you, and so that you may enjoy long life.
- 3 Hear, Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, promised you.
- 4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one.
- 5 Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.
- 6 These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts.
